The relief committee will keep close Liaison with and render full co-operating to the Govt. during the flood period operation which includes evacuation, transportation of flood/erosion affected people to relief camps, raised platforms distribution of GR. The members will inform and assist the Circle Officer, Banekuchi Rev. Circle and his staff about damage of crops, household, properties, breach of embankment any public road, damage of public institution loss of human life, cattle, any epidemics amongst flood effected people and live stock, and relief etc. to be sought from authorities.

(b) Constitution of GP Level Relief Committee:

A GP level relief committee has also been constituted under the Chairmanship of GP President of respective GP. The levels of GP Committee members are as per list attached.

The committees will not only help the Circle Officer in respective of selection of list of Flood affected families and GR distribution but also they shall keep constant contact with the undersigned during flood. Every requisition shall be through the Circle Officer and the GP level committee will distribute the GR with the help of LR Staff. Proper APRs will have to be submitted immediately after distributing GR. The LR staff of the Circle Office will keep alertness around the clock during floods and inform the Circle Officer of any eventuality arising out of or caused by floods.

(c) FLOOD ZONE:

All flood affected villages under Banekuchi Rev. Circle fall almost in a contiguous area so only one Flood Zone called "Banekuchi Flood Zone" has been constituted. The Circle Officer Banekuchi Rev. Circle will be the Zonal Officer for the Circle Flood Zone.

(d) List of proposed Relief camps as per list attached.

However depending upon the demand of the situation new camps may be opened as and when felt necessary.

(e) Probable contingency expenditure.

The Circle Officer, Banekuchi will submit all demands to the Deputy Commissioner, Nalbari for grant and release of contingency expenditure amount.

FUNCTION & RESPONSIBILITIES:

The Relief committee, headed by circle officer will be fully responsible for the overall relief operation in the circle area. Relief operation will comprise of action to be taken up before flood which encompasses developing an early warning system, monitoring the pre-flood situation and keeping essential resources ready for actual flood period. Relief operation during flood will include evacuation and transportation of flood/erosion affected people to safer areas/ relief camps, distribution of G/R etc. The members will keep close rapport with C.O., Barbhag and renders timely assistance to C.O. and his staff about information on damage of crops and household properties, damage of public institutions, loss of human lives and cattle and outbreak of epidemics among flood affected people and livestock.

The L/R staff will immediately prepare the list of flood affected people population eligible to receive G/R in consultation with concerning G.P. president and lat Gaonburahs. All requisition for G/R etc. must be submitted through the C.O.

The relief committee as whole will keep close liaison with district administration for smooth and expeditious relief operation.

For smooth management of flood relief operation, the flood prom areas have been divided into Zones & Sub-Zones. The L.M's have been placed as Zonal Officer & G.Bs as officers under the L. M's.

RESCUE OPERATION:

The Officer-in-charge of Barama PS will take necessary action for rescue operation as and when situation demands. The Committee will render all required assistance in the rescue operation.

As there is no country boat in the locality, the required country boat have to be arranged by the authority for rescue operation if situation demands.

A light vehicle will be required at Circle Office during flood visit the affected areas.

OPENING OF RELIEF CAMPS

If situation demands, the school building and other suitable available Govt. building situated comparatively at higher place will be used for relief camps.

The PWD roads, N.H.- 31, E&D bundhs will be used for shelter for affected Cattle population.

MEDICINE/DRINKING WATER

The i/c Barama PHC, i/c State Vety. Dispensary, Barama will keep sufficient stock of medicine for flood affected people and cattle population respectively. The i/c PHE, Barama will keep adequate nos. of HTW to be used during flood, if required.

GODOWN FOR G R MATERIALS

The vacant rooms of Barama Rev. Circle Offices/ Godown of Barama Co-operative Society will be used for keeping GR materials as and when required.

CONTINGENCY EXPENDITURE

The demand for contingency expenditure will be placed to the authority to meet the contingency expenses for necessary action, if situation demands.

6. TIHU REVENUE CIRCLE

The entire Tihu Revenue Circle is wholly or partially affected by flood every year during the peak monsoon period.

Two rivers, namely Tihu River and Mara pagaldia river flow through Tihu Rev. Circle.

It has been found from the past records that almost all the villages are affected by flood every year. Nearly 40,000 people and 20,000 bighas of crop land are affected by flood.

To fight the menace of flood and to supply relief materials to the flood affected people, a contingency plan has been drawn up in the following manner.

Zones : The entire circle has been divided into 3 (three) zones :

i) Namati Mouza Zone covering the area under Namati Mauza.

- ii) Tihu Zone covering the area under Tihu Mouza.
- iii) Nambarbhag Mouza Zone covering the area under Nambarbhag Mouza.

The VAS, Tihu will supervise the Namati Mouza Zone, VAS, Makhibha will supervise Nambarbhag Mouza Zone and BDO, Tihu will supervise Tihu Zone. Circle Officer, Tihu will be overall incharge of the Circle area.

Two types of committee have been formed in GP level and circle. In GP level flood relive committee, the GP Presidents, AP Members, other panchayat functionaries, Gaoanburhas, Lot Mandals, HM of Local Educational Institutions, Reputed Teachers, Anganwadi Warkers, VLEW, Representatives of flood related departments, Secretary/ President of VDP etc. will assist the Zonal officers to assess the situation and Z/O will submit requirement of relief materials to the circle officer. The Z/o will be assisted by the aforesaid functionaries in distribution of relief materials too. The Z/o will be responsible for submission of both indents for relief materials and A.P. Rs. to the circle officer.

3. PHC-LEVEL MOBILE EMERGENCY MEDICAL TEAM :

The SDM & HO i/c of the PHC will constitute a mobile emergency medical team with :

1. One Doctor
2. One pharmacist.
3. One A. N. M.
4. One dressers.
5. One 4th grade
6. One driver with a vehicle.

The SDM & HO i/c of the PHC will utilise the service of the manpower of any health institution within his jurisdiction.

4. Stock of Medicines:

Medical Appliances, Stretcher, Dressing, Materials and First - AID Materials are to be kept ready in the custody of the emergency district Medical Team.

5. Arrangement for installation and functioning of a temporary Medical and Health care centre at the site or very nearer to the site of the major disasters following the Storm & Earthquake to be kept ready.

6. Daily monitoring with stringent surveillance of the situation by the District Emergency Medical Team and the PHC in-charges with intimation to the immediate higher authority.

7. Communication Network :

1. Any doctor of the affected area will immediately inform the situation to the PHC i/c with intimation to the Jt. DHS, Nalbari

2. The PHC i/c will immediately send the PHC mobile emergency team to the site of devastation with immediate intimation to the Jt. DHS, Nalbari and to the Circle Officer. He will mobilise and utilise the services of other doctors and paramedicals of his area in a team spirit as and when necessary with intimation to the Jt. DHS.

3. The Jt. DHS, Nalbari in turn will provide additional manpower including medicines, dressing materials, stretcher from the DMS

4. The DMS (District Medical Stores) will keep adequate stock of medicines, dressing materials, stretchers etc. to meet any emergency situations as and when necessary.

8. Health Education

To create awareness among the public and the N.G.O.s by extensive education to prevent the casualties following the Storm & Earthquake. The B. E. E., public health workers and the Health Educators will arrange public meeting in collaboration with the local NGOs, teachers, Panchayat workers and the opinion leaders.

2. Functioning of emergency district medical team:

Six emergency district Medical teams formed with the following Medical & Paramedical staffs in each team.

1. One SDM & HO from the district H.Q.
2. Two Doctors residing in Nalbari twon.
3. Two Public Health works.

4. Two Malaria workers.
5. One grade - IV staff.
6. One driver with a good condition vehicle.

Every day two groups will render their emergency services. One group from 8 AM to 2PM and the other from 2 PM to 8 PM. The team will attend any emergency situation in respect of outbreak of diarrhoea, dysentery, fever, any waterborne, foodborne and airborne disease.

3. Functioning of block level emergency medical team :

A block level emergency Medical team is formed in each block with the following staff:

1. One Doctor
2. One Pharmacist.
3. One A.N.M.
4. One Malaria worker
5. One public Health worker.
6. One grade -IV
7. One driver.

The above team will attend any emergency post-disaster situation in their jurisdiction immediately and will report to the Jt. D.H.S., Nalbari for further action. The Block PHC having no vehicle will send urgent message to the Jt. D.H.S., Nalbari for arrangement of the vehicle , The SDM & HO, i/c of the Block PHC will collect medicines from the D.M.S., Nalbari for use in the Post-disaster health hazards.

4. Functioning of the peripheral emergency medical team :

A peripheral emergency medical team is formed in each peripheral Health institution with the following staffs:

1. One Doctor/Pharmacist
2. One Paramedical Staff.
3. One Grade -IV

The team will immediately attend any emergency post-disaster situation and will render emergency services to the ailing patients with a report to the SDM & HO, i/c their PHC.

5. Holding of public awareness meeting :

A. The SDM & HO , i/c block PHC is requested to hold public awareness meeting in his jurisdiction in the disaster affected areas to impart massive health education in respect of disaster related diseases.

B. The SDM & HO (Public Health duty) and the SDM & HO (Epidemic) are requested to hold public awareness meeting in the vulnerable & flood affected areas for taking necessary preventive measures by the public and to get rid of the post-disaster related diseases.

6. Organisation of health check-up camps :

In places of out break of Fever, Diarrhoea & other post-disaster related diseases not controlled by the Block PHC or when desired by the SDM & HO, i/c Block PHC - Free Health check-up camps will be organised by the doctors, paramedicals & other staff from the HQ immediately to control & contain any outbreak.

7. Surveillance & Monitoring :

Multipurpose health workers are directed to do active surveillance in respect of fever cases, diarrhoea & dysentery cases, Jaundice cases and other disaster related diseases and to report to their respective SDM & HO, i/c of the Block PHC who in turn will submit report to the undersigned for necessary action and onward transmission.

8. Inspection of foods :

Food inspector of the district is directed to inspect the food materials in the markets of the flood affected areas and to report to the undersigned for taking necessary action. The district administration will be moved for banning any contaminated food.

9. Disinfection of water:

Disinfection of drinking water sources is to be done to prevent water borne diseases. Water samples being collected from the suspected contaminated water by the P.H. workers. The sample have been sent to the microbiology Deptt., G.M.C.H., Guwahati for analysis. Necessary disinfection is to be done after receiving the analysis reports.

10. Stock of medicines & disinfectants :

Medicines and disinfectants are supplied by the D.H.S., Assam . The SDM & HO. i/c DMS, Nalbari is directed to keep all essential Medicines & disinfectants ready for the emergency use as and when necessary. He is requested to submit emergency indent of medicines to DHS, Assam and to collect the same in time.

EXTENTION MEASURES RELATING TO LATEST RESULTS OF AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH:

(I) KHARIF SEASON:

I. Rice varieties suitable for delayed planting Prafulla, Gitesh, and Manohar Sali :

Can be transplanted late up to 30th September with overage seedling of 60-70days. Seedling can be raised normally and planting can be done when situation becomes favorable. Seed rate is 50-60 kg/ha as no. of seedling per hill will be 6-7. A closer spacing of 20-cm.x15 cm. is to be maintained

II. Rice varieties tolerant to submergence: Jalashree, Jalkuori and Plaban: -

Can tolerate submergence tolerance level of up to 1,0 M and upto a period of 10-15 days Seedlings are to be raised during early June and transplanting is to be done during early July with 30 days old seedling. Seed requirement in a hectare is 45 kg. Seedling to be transplanted per hill is 2-3 no.

III. Early rice variety suitable for direct seeding:

Luit and Disang (90-95 days) : Suitable for direct seeding of sprouted seeds onto puddle land. These varieties are also suitable for wet seeding directly on silted area. Direct- seedling should be done within 10th September. Seed rate per ha of land for direct – seedling is 75-80 kg.

The result of testing and demonstration conducted by KVK Nalbari, proved that through Luit is a better yielder, Disang ha has the preferable grain quality.

IV. Early varieties suitable for delayed transplanting:

Luit and Disang (95-100 days): Suitable for tyransplanting till 15th. September with 21 days old seedling can be raised by Dapog method also under flooded conditions. Seed rate per ha is 50 kg. Closer spacing of 15 cm x 10 cm must be maintained.

V. Kharif pulses suitable for sitted area / after flood : Green gram: Variety -

Pratap and K. 851: Can be sown up to 15th. September with a seed rate of 20 -25 kg/ ha. The crop can also be sown in silted area after recession of flood with zero tillage at moisture level.

VI. Raising of Community Nursery:

Necessary measures for raising Sali paddy seedling throughs through Community Nurseries may be taken up at PPS level to meet the demand of Sali paddy seedlings in case seedlings raised by farmers are damaged.

Varieties : Ranjit, Bahadur and Pankaj : For areas affected by early floods (June – July) Varieties : Late planted including Monoharsali, Thagaguri and Moinaguri : For area affected by recurring and late floods (August – early September).

VII. Cultural Practices to be followed by farmers:

1. Maintenance of Plant Population: Appropriate spacing as specified in case of varieties is to be maintained for obtaining desired level of plant population.

2. Gap filling: Gap filling with seedlings of same variety and same age should be done within 7 – 10 days after transplanting.

3. Top dressing of fertilizer: Urea @ 3 kg and MOP @2 kg/ bigha may be to top- dressed in standing Sali crop at 25 – 30 days after transplanting. If there is standing water in the field urea should be mined with FYM power and incubated before application.

4. Plant protection : Case worm is expected to be major pest after flood. Stem Borer, Swarming caterpillar and Rice hispa may appear to be other damaging pests at vegetative stage. Disease appearance may not be significant after flood as humidity level declines. IPM strategies are to be taken up expeditiously when pest attack exceeds economic threshold level. In case of severity, recommended pesticides may be applied.

5. Cropping Systems to be followed:

The most effective systems to be followed are:

- a. Summer paddy – Fallow – Late Sali
- b. Summer Paddy – Fallow – Wheat / Oilseeds / Pulses
- c. Early Ahu – Sali paddy – Pulses/ Oilseeds
- d. Khari vegetables – Fallow – Rabi vegetables
- e. Summer paddy – Fallow – Fallow
- f. Jute – Fallow – Wheat / Oilseeds / Pulses.

IV) PHE, NALBARI DIVISION

The Jurisdiction of Nalbari PHE Division comprises of the following Development Blocks, viz: i) Barbhag Dev. Block, ii) Pub-Nalbari Dev. Block, iii) Borigog Banbhag Dev. Block, iv) Madhupur Dev. Block (Part), v) Barama Dev. Block (Part) and vi) Tihu Dev. Block. Out of these six Development Blocks the villages under i), ii) and iii) are likely to be worst affected by flood water.

The flood water submersed vast areas under these blocks making life of villagers miserable. At the same time flood water enters in piped water supply schemes, submerge spot sources making it unfit for human consumption or make these sources defunct. So, the division takes the responsibility of providing safe drinking water to the marooned and stranded flood victims in the river banks, dykes, relief camps etc.

Main task in pre and post flood is to disinfect all the spot sources and all possible efforts to keep all the spot sources functional, so that the villagers do not have to cry for safe drinking water during the flood period.

Regarding fresh installation of HTW in flood areas, instruction has already been issued not to install any HTW by the department except imparting technical assistance by PHED as and when asked by the Civil Authority.

V) PWD NALBARI RURAL ROADS DEPARTMENT :

The PWD Nalbari Rural Roads Division, Nalbari has proposed following relief measures to be taken during flood 2006.

- a) Collection and supply of river gravels, sand gravels, Brick Bats etc. for maintenance of communication including temporary plugging of breaches. Amount estimated at Rs. 80.00 Lakhs.
- b) Providing Bamboo Palasiding, temporary spur, Cements bags, pitching for protection of bridges and Culverts. Amount estimated at Rs. 30.00 Lakhs.
- c) Providing and lunching of tree branches for protection of roads erosion. Amount estimated at Rs. 10.00 Lakhs.
- d) Construction of Foot Bridges. Amount estimated at Rs. 20.00 Lakhs.

VI) A.H & VETERINARY DEPARTMENT :

- a) 31 Numbers of flood relief team consisting VAS/EO (Vety), S VFA, VFA and Gr-IV staff for rendering veterinary aids to the affected animals in the flood affected areas has been constituted.
- b) Requisition of medicine, Instrument , Appliances, Vaccines, Green Fodder and Cattle feeds have been place to the concerned authority accordingly.
- c) Selected High land to protect the flood affected animal during flood.
- d) All the officers and staff of the district has been instructed not to leave respective H.Q. during the flood and VAS/EO (Vety) has been asked to submit daily report of the flood occurs in any places of the district.

VII) FOOD & CIVIL SUPPLIES:

All the area inspectors and Sub-Inspectors under F & CS, Nalbari are detailed for performing flood relief duties with concerned Circle officers in addition to their own duties in their respective areas.

The Chambers of Commerce and F.C.I, Nalbari are requested to ensured stock and stuffs sufficiently in the open Market as well as no undue hike in open Market prices.
